

LOTHIAN CAR CLUB (EDINBURGH) LTD REGULATIONS 2010

This year there will be three two-day hill climb meetings at Doune.

The April Doune meeting is two one day events, which will host two rounds of the Guyson Scottish Hill Climb Championship, one on Saturday and one on Sunday. Competitors wishing to enter only one day may do so.

The April Doune meeting is a Historic meeting and forms part of the Scottish Historic Championship.

The June and September Doune meetings are National A British Championship rounds run to British Championship and MSA regulations.

To accommodate those new to Hill Climbing who have as yet not enough experience to obtain a National A licence there will be a separate National B event. Those competitors entering the National B event should expect to run at a different time and in a different class from those entered in the National A event.

The committee reserves the right to refuse entries for any reason.

All the events are run in compliance with the MSA yearbook regulations and any dispensations given.

1. ENTERING EVENTS

We accept entries for all the Lothian Car Club events at the start of the season. Refunds will be as specified in the ASR should you be unable to compete at a particular event. Please ensure that your entry is accompanied by a cheque for the correct amount and is received prior to the closing date.

Please also ensure that if you have to cancel an entry, you advise the Competition Secretary as soon as possible. This will give others a chance to take your place. Entries will not be acknowledged unless a written request is made and a stamped addressed envelope is supplied by the competitor and marked 'Entry Acknowledgement'.

2. DOUNE SELF-STARTING

At Doune it is helpful if cars are capable of re-starting in the holding paddock. This is usually achieved by sending a spare starting battery to the holding paddock on the breakdown truck at the start of the meeting. Lothian Car Club will provide a 12v battery to assist starting. Other equipment required may be sent at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course on the breakdown truck during the meeting. Historic and other cars without self starting need to advise the officials on the entry form so arrangements can be made.

3. CLASSES

Please check the number of the class you are entering in Appendices I. Due to the number of championships being catered for, the class structure may not match the championship format to which you are used. Please ensure you have a licence appropriate to the class and vehicle you enter.

4. CAR NUMBERS

Black and white Numbers may be available at sign-on at a reasonable price. Please note "Blue Book" provisions regarding numbers.

5. DOUBLE ENTRIES

Please mark clearly on entry forms the principal and second drivers. The principal driver will run in class, the second driver will normally run in the batch preceding.

6. SCOOTERS

The use of motorised scooters or similar in the paddock is not permitted.

7. DOGS AND ANIMALS

Following a recommendation from the Health & Safety Executive, please note that animals are no longer allowed at Doune. Animals may be left in the camping/car park area provided they are securely housed.

8. CARAVANS/MOTOR HOMES/CAMPING

A fee of £5 per caravan/motor home/tent will be charged. You can purchase a camping/caravanning ticket at signing on. Camping/caravanning tickets must be clearly displayed. *The landowners at Doune have requested that no caravans, motor homes, support vehicles or tents be situated on top of the knoll inside the first gate of the camping paddock.* Please comply with this request, otherwise you will be asked to move your vehicle. The caravan and camping area is only available from Noon on the Friday till 11pm on the Sunday. Competitors can be accommodated in the paddock on Sunday night

9. Bo'ness Revival Hill Climb

Bo'ness is on the 11th and 12th September 2010 and those of you who proposed doing Doune as well may wish to consider leaving your trailer and car locally to save a drive. The meetings will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A.), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

3. **The April Doune National B event is** open to competitors who hold a National B licence or higher and are members of any Motor Club that is part of the Scottish Sprint, Hillclimb and Speed Championship and Lothian car Club. Membership and Registration Cards must be shown.

The June & September Doune National B event is open to competitors who only hold a National B licence and are members of any Motor Club that is part of the Scottish Sprint, Hillclimb and Speed Championship, the HSA Championship and Lothian car Club who only hold National B licences. Membership and Registration Cards must be shown at the event.

The June and September Doune National A events are open to all competitors holding a valid MSA Speed or Race National A or International Competition Licence or the equivalent RIAC licence.

4. All competitors and drivers must produce a valid Competition Licence appropriate to the class of vehicle.
5. Scrutineering at all events will be in class order according to the times specified in the final instructions. Cars must be ready for scrutineering at the correct time with the driver in attendance - if not competitors may lose their practice run.

6. APRIL DOUNE MEETING

The April meeting will include two rounds of the Guyson Scottish Hill Climb Championship; one round on Saturday afternoon, and one round on Sunday afternoon. Competitors will need to sign on and be scrutineered on both days.

APRIL DOUNE PRACTICE

Saturday starts 0900 hrs.

Sunday starts 0900 hrs or later at the discretion of the Clerk of Course

APRIL DOUNE TIMED RUNS

On both days, first timed runs will commence at a time to be announced by the Clerk of the course on the day.

7. JUNE AND SEPTEMBER DOUNE MEETINGS

FOR THESE MEETINGS WE RUN TWO EVENTS AND WILL STOP THE FIRST MEETING AND THEN START THE SECOND AT VARIOUS POINTS DURING THE DAY. THE FOLLOWING APPLIES TO BOTH EVENTS.

JUNE & SEPTEMBER DOUNE SATURDAY PRACTICE

Saturday starts 0900 hrs

Competitors must practice on Saturday to be eligible to compete on the Sunday following and will be expected to make two practice runs and if time permits may make further practice runs. Further practice runs are at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course

JUNE & SEPTEMBER DOUNE SUNDAY PRACTICE

It is hoped to have *limited* practice commencing at 0900 hrs but this will only be available to competitors who have completed their Saturday practice. Sunday practice maybe curtailed to suit prevailing conditions.

JUNE & SEPTEMBER DOUNE TIMED RUNS

First timed runs will commence on Sunday at a time to be announced by the Clerk of the course on the day.

8. All drivers and vehicles must comply with MSA Technical Regulations.
9. The length of the Doune course is some 1,350 metres.
10. Classes are shown in Appendices I.
11. Awards and Trophies are shown in Appendix II.

Cheques in settlement of entry fees will not be accepted if dated after the closing date of the event to which they relate. Club membership is £20 so significant savings can be made by joining the club when entering several rounds.

The maximum entry for each meeting is 130. The minimum entry will be 50. The minimum entry for each class will be 5. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right either to cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary.

In the event of any meeting being over-subscribed, entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Committee and in accordance with championship regulations.

14. Provisional results will be posted at the Secretary's office as soon as possible after each class or following the end of the event and within 2 hours of the conclusion of the event. Printed results will be emailed to competitors during the week following the event or handed out at the event. If you would prefer results to be posted to you please circle the appropriate answer on the entry form.
15. Cars will start singly. The starting signal will be a GREEN LIGHT. Timing will be electronic and starts when the vehicle interrupts a light beam. The finish line will be indicated by chequer boards and / or a white line. A timing strut complying with the MSA regulations must be fitted
16. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with MSA Regulations
17. Running order will be the class order, running order within the classes being stated in the Official Entry List.

18. Competitors will be identified by numbers which will not be supplied by the organiser, but **may** be on sale at the events. For safety reasons, numbers complying in all respects with the MSA Year book definition of size etc. must be displayed on both sides and the front of each car so that they are clearly visible from marshals' posts located on both the left, right and above the track.
19. Marking and penalties at June and September Doune will be as provided in the appropriate section of the Speed Championships General Regulations.
20. All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written.
21. There will be two practice runs each event and drivers are permitted to walk the course prior to the drivers briefing. Drivers whose practice run is interrupted by a RED FLAG will only be allowed a rerun at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.
22. At all events when shown a red flag the driver will bring the car to a stop and await verbal instruction from a marshal.
23. If any competitor is under the age of 18 years a parent/guardian signed consent form must accompany their entry.
24. It is a condition of the landowners at Doune that the site is open to competitors from mid-day on the Friday until mid-day on Monday of any weekend during which a competition is being organised. Caravans may only be parked in the area approved by the organisers. If this causes a problem please contact the Secretary of the Meeting.
25. Double entries are acceptable if entry forms are clearly marked. First and second drivers must be nominated on the Entry Form; the first driver will run in class, the second driver will usually run in the class preceding. The running order for double entries will be intimated in the running order.
26. A competitor notifying the Secretary in writing:
 - a. prior to the closing date for entries for that event, will be entitled to a refund of his entry fee.
 - b. at any time after the closing date for that event, but no later than 5 days before the meeting, to a refund of his entry fee on deduction of an administration fee of £5.00 provided in all cases that all passes in respect of the event are returned to the Secretary prior to the meeting.
27. In the event of cancellation or postponement of the event for more than 24 hours, entry fees will be refunded less an administration fee of £5.00.
28. At the request of the Doune landowners; parking is prohibited at all times on the tarmac access road and competitors do not run competition cars on the same, at any time.
29. Appointments will be made to declare on unsatisfactory starts or starting infringements.
30. In determining the awarding of trophies, any competitor who wins a fastest time of day award will be excluded from the individual class results.

31. The driver of any vehicle that is claiming admission in a class for road-Going vehicles or a Racing or Sports Libre vehicle claiming driver National A (open) licence dispensation must produce as appropriate a current Road Tax Disc, MOT and Insurance Certificate to the Scrutineer. Fleet policy insurance documents are not acceptable as all documents must contain the vehicles registration number in the original document.

32. Drivers at the April events in the D Division may use Methanol fuel subject to the car complying with the appropriate regulations.

33. Drivers may use Methanol or Bio fuel subject to the car complying with the appropriate regulations and the appropriate championships allowing the use of that specific fuel.
